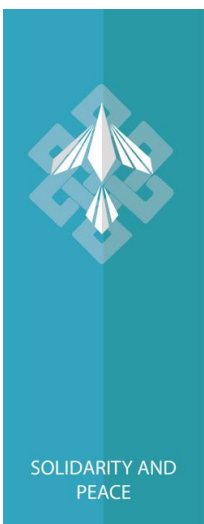
At Our Lady of Lourdes, we understand that all living things are connected so we must do what we can to take care of our common home so that it meets the needs of everyone, now and in the future.
